## General Consultant Paediatrician

Part Time Equivalent

Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre and The Barrie Paediatric Associates are seeking a 0.6 FTE General Consultant Paediatrician to join the group effective immediately. We would also be interested in candidates who have experience or training in adolescent medicine.

The successful applicant will join a group of 14 consultant paediatricians and will practice in a variety of settings including outpatient office based clinics, hospital based sub specialty clinics and hospital inpatient and emergency coverage. In addition, the applicant will be expected to participate in general paediatric call at RVH. Remuneration is through the provincial Alternate Payment Plan and involves a combination of salary, fee-for-service billings and sessional fees.

All candidates must be certified or eligible for certification in Paediatric Medicine from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and be eligible for an Ontario license through the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO).

RVH currently has 319 beds plus 12 bassinets in the Level 2C Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). There are currently 16 Obstetrical beds, 8 Paediatric beds and over 2,000 babies born each year at RVH. RVH has a very busy emergency department with approximately 85,000 visits per year with paediatrics representing about 17% of those visits. The Paediatricians/Neonatologists see approximately 2,200 children annually within the outpatient program. The Paediatricians will see their patients in the hospital's Outpatient Child & Youth Treatment Clinic while they are on call so they are readily available to all of their patients.

RVH has many academic partnerships and affiliations including an official partnership with the University of Toronto, Department of Family and Community Medicine.
