Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre and The Barrie Paediatric Associates are seeking a 1.0 FTE General Consultant Paediatrician to join the group effective immediately. We would also be interested in candidates who have experience or training in adolescent medicine.

The successful applicant will join a group of 12 consultant paediatricians and will practice in a variety of settings including outpatient office based clinics, hospital based subspecialty clinics and hospital inpatient and emergency coverage. In addition, the applicant will be expected to participate in general paediatric call at RVH. Remuneration is through the provincial Alternate Payment Plan and involves a combination of salary, fee-for-service billings and sessional fees.

All candidates must be certified or eligible for certification in Paediatric Medicine from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and be eligible for an Ontario license through the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO).

RVH currently has 319 beds plus 12 bassinets in the Level 2C Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). There are currently 16 Obstetrical beds, 8 Paediatric beds and over 2,000 babies born each year at RVH. RVH has a very busy emergency department with approximately 85,000 visits per year with paediatrics representing about 17% of those visits. RVH has many academic partnerships and affiliations including an official partnership with the University of Toronto, Department of Family and Community Medicine.

## Royal Victoria Regional Health Centre Paediatric Program

### RVH Paediatric Program:

Children at RVH are cared for using a multidisciplinary team approach. Team members include Paediatricians and Neonatologists, specially trained nurses and a social worker, all of whom have special certifications to enhance the care and the quality of service that children receive. The Paediatric Program is comprised of a group of 12 Consultant Paediatricians - two are board certified in NICU and one is board certified in PICU. The others are General Paediatricians with special interests in certain specialties (respirology, endocrine, development, complex care etc.).

All of the Paediatricians run their own busy private offices, where they see patients on a consultative basis. In addition, the Paediatricians have several subspecialty clinics (including asthma, diabetes, complex care, eating disorders, school success, and neonatal follow up).

The group offers comprehensive hospital coverage with a hospitalist covering all inpatients and emergency consults, and a neonatologist covering our level 2 NICU. Furthermore, the group provides 24/7 on call coverage for all paediatrics and neonatology services.

RVH completed one of the largest capital projects in Simcoe Muskoka history. The expansion project almost doubled the size of the hospital, adding an additional 400,000 square feet of space, and capacity for 165 additional inpatient beds, including a dedicated Cardiac Care Unit; significant expansions of the Emergency Department, Diagnostic Imaging and Laboratory; two additional Operating Rooms. In addition to the significant expansion, another 100,000 square feet of the current facility will undergo extensive renovations over the next several years.
