Pediatrician Opportunities

Yarmouth Regional Hospital (YRH) is seeking two full-time pediatricians to provide consulting care in both inpatient and outpatient practice settings with possible satellite clinics in Shelburne and Digby. Physicians also have an opportunity to work as a preceptor with medical students and residents in addition to offering their expertise on pediatric care to various committees. There is an affiliation with IWK Children's Hospital in Halifax which provides travelling sub-specialty clinics, telehealth grand rounds, and an air transport program.

License and Eligibility

Candidates must be eligible for licensure with the [College of Physicians and Surgeons of Nova Scotia](#) (CPSNS), eligible for certification with the [Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada](#) (RCPSC) and hold membership with the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA).

Remuneration

Remuneration options include an Alternative Payment Plan (APP) (up to \$350,000 annually). In addition, call stipends and other incentives are available through the Master Agreement between the Province of Nova Scotia and Doctors Nova Scotia.

Incentives

Nova Scotia Health offers a comprehensive site visit program and will cover eligible relocation expenses. Virtual and in-person site visits are available.
