About our Hospitals:

HPHA is an Alliance of four hospitals located in Southwestern Ontario, including Clinton Public, Seaforth Community, St Marys Memorial, and Stratford General.

Stratford General Hospital is 120 bed hospital and the largest hospital in the HPHA. It is the regional referral centre for Huron and Perth County residents, offering a broad range of medical and surgical inpatient services including critical care and neo-natal intensive care, supported with internists, pediatricians and surgical specialists such as ENT, ophthalmology, plastics, urology, general surgery and orthopedics.
